



CHISPA SCHOLARSHIPS

Community Foundation for Monterey County Scholarship applicants are eligible if they or their parents currently live in a CHISPA apartment building, a rental home constructed or renovated by CHISPA, a home purchased from CHISPA by their family, or a Self-Help Home constructed by their family through CHISPA's Mutual Self Help Housing program.



Deadline: March 15, 2020

Students can apply through the CFMC online scholarship system. Go directly to a description of the CHISPA Scholarship at <https://cfmco.academicworks.com/> and start an application by clicking on "Sign Up" in the top right corner. Check the box on the application that says the student or their parents live in a CHISPA Community. Completing the application will also match the student with any of CFMC's scholarships for which they are eligible.

Applicants should have documented financial need, 2.0 or higher GPA, demonstrated perseverance in overcoming challenges, and good character. Preference may be given to students not attending Hartnell College or CSU Monterey Bay.
